

# Bond Breaker Tape

## Polyethylene tape, for isolating sealants from concrete and joint fillers

### Uses

Polyethylene tape for isolating sealant and eliminating sealant adhesion to concrete, metals and joint filler boards.

Used in joint sealing applications, Bond Breaker Tape stops joint sealants from adhering to surfaces and preventing "3 sided adhesion" which limits the sealants ability to accommodate movement.

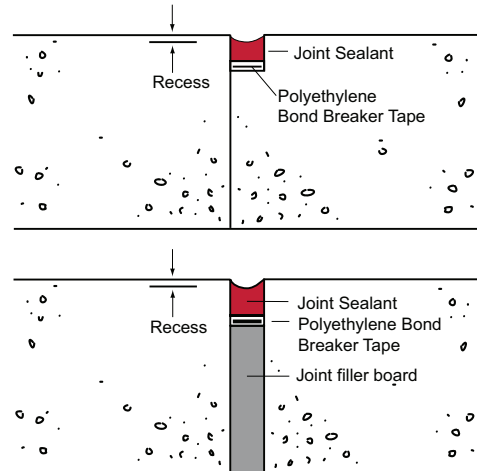
### Description

Bond breaker Tape is black self adhesive polyethylene tape that has excellent conformability to irregular surfaces.



## Application Instructions

Clean joint surface, free from dust and other contaminants.



In a typical joint the sealant should adhere to both opposite surfaces of the sealant slot but not to its base, leading to two sided adhesion; not three sided adhesion.

To prevent the sealant adhering to the base surface or filler board, apply Bond Breaker Tape along the whole width / length of base of the joint.

Bond Breaker Tape is supplied in 66m rolls, available in the following widths:

15 mm, 20 mm, 25 mm, 50 mm
