

# Aluminium oxide grit for slip resistance on resinous floor finishes

#### Uses

Nitoflor Anti-Slip grains 11 are designed for use with Nitoflor resin-based products to produce non-slip industrial floors. Ideal for wet zones and for floors that require hot water or steam cleaning. Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 are used for areas where safety is the highest priority, i.e., abattoir flooring.

## Description

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 is #16 Aluminium Oxide aggregate with an angular profile to provide positive traction on resinous floor finishes such as Nitoflor PU600 / PU200.

# **Design Criteria**

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 is applied as a broadcast application into the base coat of resinous flooring. The grit is then encased with the second sealer coat application of resinous flooring.

Application rate of Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 will vary for different resin-based flooring taking in consideration the slip rating requirement

## **Specification Clause**

#### Slip resistant floor finish

The resinous floor finish shall incorporate Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 applied at a rate not less than (*nominate 2 to 3*)  $kg/m^2$  applied into the freshly applied first coat of resinous flooring.

Sizing (nominal):	0.5mm to 1.0mm

## **Application Instructions**

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 are applied as a broadcast application into the freshly applied first roll coat of resinous floor finish at the nominated rate. Refer to the individual Nitoflor product data sheets for typical slip resistance test results.

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 should be allowed to fall vertically onto the resin coating rather than be thrown across the surface, as this may cause ridges in the resin flooring.

After the base floor coating has hardened, any excess grit is removed by vacuum and the second / sealer coat of resinous flooring is applied to encapulate the grit.

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11 20kg: FC611081-20kg

#### Coverage

Nitoflor Anti-Slip Grains 11: 2 to 3kg/m<sup>2</sup>

The coverage figures given are theoretical - due to wastage factors and the variety and nature of possible substrates, practical coverage figures will be reduced.

#### Storage

Store in dry conditions in original packaging.
