Electrical Resistivity Testing

Sample Preparation:

Standard cylinder samples (200 x 100 mm diameter) were cast by SGS as per Parchem's instructions. Samples were demoulded at 24 hours and cured in limewater at 23 ± 2 °C until test dates.

Test Method:

In general accordance to the AASHTO method, "Surface Resistivity Indication of Concrete's Ability to Resist Chloride Ion Penetration".

Readings taken at 50 mm spacing using a Proceq Resipod 50 mm.

This Certificate of Test replaces Certificate of Test No. 12080 which is now withdrawn.
